(Final Questions)

Read Romans 3:23, John 3:16-17, and Romans 2:1-9

"Salvation is a free gift from God; it is by grace through faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ on the Cross that we might be saved. In the sacrificial death and resurrection of Jesus, God has made the way by which we can be saved."

Do you agree with this definition of Salvation? Why/why not?

Look at the following scriptures to answer what we need to be saved from:

Man needs to be saved from	Romans 7:7-14
Man needs to be saved from	John 3:36, Romans 1:18
Man needs to be saved from	Romans 3:19-20, Romans 4:15
Man needs to be saved from	Luke 16:19-31, Revelation 20:11-15

Read John 10:10 and Romans 12:2 and answer the following question: *What is man saved for?*
